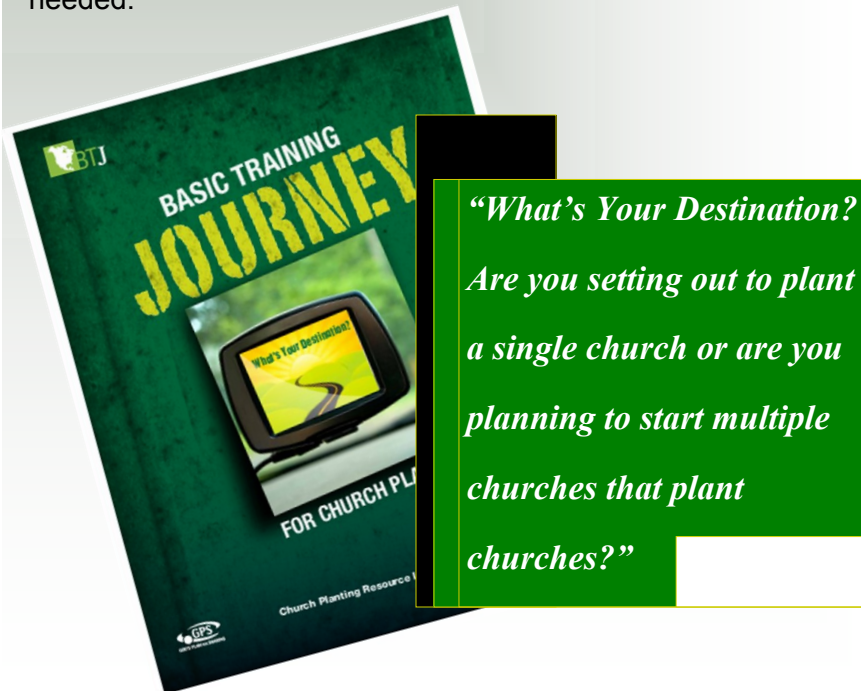

Overview
